
What we can do for you...

The nature of outreach support and training provided by Frank Wise School is focussed around enabling schools and other organisations to develop their skills in enabling children and young adults with learning disabilities to progress.

With this in mind, we are able to offer the following...

Individual Pupil Outreach Referrals

An initial visit to include

- a classroom observation
- a professional discussion to identify the specific requirements of the referral
- a subsequent record of the outcomes of that discussion
- an agreed plan for future support where appropriate

Cost: £75

(this entitles a receiving organisation to one free place on one of our twilight training sessions - this place should be booked direct with Frank Wise School)

Follow up visits to a setting which may include

- working alongside teaching and support staff
- detailed assessment of pupil's learning
- support with target setting
- advice on teaching strategies and resources to support progress towards targets
- advice on behaviour management
- a written report at the end of the visits

Cost: Schools will be charged £175 per half day (to include time for preparation and report writing)



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School to School Support

Twilight Training Sessions at Frank Wise School
