## **OfSTED Inspection Framework Consultation**

Currently, OfSTED are consulting on a new inspection framework that has a greater focus on the curriculum, something which is at the heart of what we do at Frank Wise. However, OfSTED has failed to include any research on Special Schools or specifically on children with SEND in the evidence base they have used to design the inspection framework. They have also only visited two Special schools when trialling their new approach, only one of which was similar to Frank Wise.
