

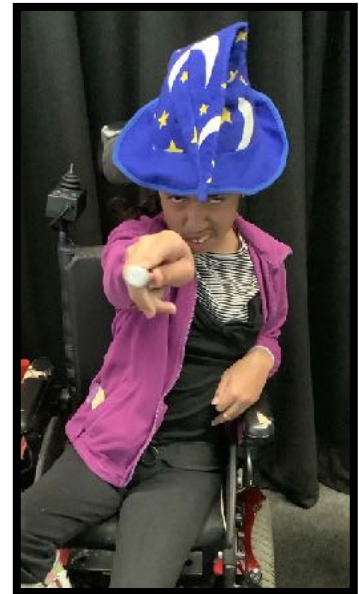


## Welcome Back
