



Trips and Visits

One of the key parts of the work of the school is to ensure that our curriculum is enhanced by opportunities for off-site learning, trips and visits. It has been a while since we have been able to do this in the way we would like due to the impact of the pandemic. However, we have recently restarted our programme of residential trips, reintroducing children to coming away with school by taking part in some shorter and relatively local visits.



We have also hosted the local Fire Brigade who came to the school site to show pupils within the school around their fire engine. The pupils were delighted to see an emergency vehicle so close up and find out more about the work of the Fire Service. Pupils in the 7th Family Group were also able to get on board a local bus, courtesy of Stagecoach and DCS. The bus was too big to come onto the school site, so local business leader Denys Shortt came to our assistance and offered to host the visit at his logistics centre in Banbury, so that the pupils could continue their hands on learning about public transport.
