
Wise Up Autumn 2023



This term 2FG have been exploring food!


Each week we have tried different foods, and given our opinions on their look, taste and smell.

Pupils have painted lines, shapes, dots, splodges, criss crosses, block colours and everything else in between!




















SFG Class Magazine

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






Validation Processions IN 7FG

Our other visit was to a construction site! We got to test out different machines, like this water suction machine!


















