

PE and Sport Premium Report - 2024/25

The Department for Education requires that the PE and Sport Premium must be used to fund additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport for the benefit of primary age pupils in the 2024/25 academic year. This is with the intention of encouraging the development of healthy and active lifestyles.

At Frank Wise School, the Sports Premium is used, in accordance with DfE requirements, to support engagement and achievement of all primary aged pupils, following our inclusive ethos.

The principles underlying our use of this grant are that we want to:

- Prioritise the physical ability of all pupils to engage with movement and physical activity in ways which ensure that they access opportunities which promote a healthy and active lifestyle, but which also support their access to education as a result of improved physical condition.
- Ensure that the staff working with our children are as highly skilled in teaching sports and physical development as possible, supported by external expertise.
- Provide the best PE and Motor Impaired equipment that we can, ensuring that we achieve our inclusive expectations of all pupils participating in high quality PE and sport.

Funding allocation	Use of Funding	Impact of Funding
£5850	Staff CPD - Motor Impaired Co-ordinator	We have sustained the provision of expertise in the area of Motor Education to support the assessment of need in children with complex physical development profiles. This also enables us to provide training and support to classroom staff in the completion of motor impaired education programmes and the monitoring of the appropriateness of those programmes. The Motor Education Lead also liaises with other therapy services.
£500	PE Resources and expertise	Staff have access to equipment which ensures that we are able to include all pupils in PE and sporting activity both within the context of taught subjects and play, as well as during our annual Sports Day.
£10190	Top-Up swimming sessions for all pupils	Providing weekly swimming and water safety lessons to all pupils, as well as providing additional weekly hydrotherapy sessions for pupils with complex physical development needs. Contribution to the ongoing running costs associated with the pool in order to maintain staffing levels necessary for the safe operation and effective water safety and swimming education of the pupils.
